


MSF e-Course Access

Please review the minimum system requirements before attempting to access the MSF Basic eCourse:

Minimum System Requirements

- Internet connection: Broadband connections work best. The *MSF eCourses* are video intensive.
- Browser support: Current versions of Chrome, Safari and Firefox are all supported. For Internet Explorer, version 10 or above is supported.
- Be sure JavaScript is enabled on your browser.
- The *eCourses* render best on a desktop computer with at least 1024x768 resolution.
- The *eCourses* require Adobe Flash so they will not work on an iPad.
- The *eCourses* are not optimized for mobile phones or modern tablets.
- You will need access to a printer at the end of the courses to print a completion certificate.

To get to the e-Course, open your email confirmation letter, and click on the link under “e-Course Website” in the “eCourse Login Credentials” of your letter.

4. The eCourse doesn't load correctly on my iPad, (or any other tablet).
5. My video will not start or load.
6. If I cannot finish my online course in one sitting, do I have to start from the beginning or will it save where I last left off?
7. I cannot log into the eCourse and seem to have locked myself out

Obtaining the eCourse certificate

Once you have completed and passed the MSF Basic eCourse, wait until the audio on the final slide has fully played itself through. (This is important because if you do not, you will not be able to access your certificate, as the program will think you are not finished.) When the audio is finished and you have received the message that you have completed, click on “Exit” in the bottom right corner of the screen to get you back to the eCourse menu:
